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Editorial

Dear colleagues, dear members of the GMP,

This year 2021 will be, we all hope, the year of the return to a physical congress for the GMP days. Our congress will indeed take place in Paris on the dates planned. However, the Institut Pasteur, initially planned as the site of our 2021 conference, does not currently offer sufficient guarantees to welcome us under the conditions initially planned. It is therefore, we will meet at the <u>Espaces</u> <u>Diderot</u> for GMP 2021 meeting. Thank you to the board of directors for having reacted quickly and succeeded in identifying a new Parisian site offering the required conditions for the successful organization of our congress.

The scientific committee has prepared a very beautiful program this year again, focused on the place of DMPK in the development of therapies based on pharmacologically active agents (small or large molecules) but also on cell-based treatments, vaccines, or via approaches integrating the microbiota.

On the agenda of our congress, sessions dedicated to: the optimization of the prediction of pharmacodynamic or toxicological effects via the use of "Organ-On-a-chip" assay systems, the regulatory strategy for bioequivalence studies and the predictive use of PBPK models, the role of microbiota in health, the therapeutics PK/PD challenges in viral (oncolytic) or antiviral (chemical) treatments, the use of PK in vaccine development, relevant biomarkers for personalized medicine, and the use of pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics in cell therapy.

This year, the Poster blitz session, which gives students the opportunity to present their work, will be chaired by Carla Troisi, winner of the GMP 2020 conference and member of the scientific committee.

Professor Dr. Michael Zimmerman (EMBL - Medicen) will be our keynote speaker and will talk about the contributions of the microbiota on drug metabolism and toxicity. The theme of the "on step aside" session will be dedicated to the history of vaccines from smallpox to COVID-19 by Professor Maxime Schwartz (Institut Pasteur).

Finally, as we did in 2019 in Lyon, two free satellite sessions will be offered on Wednesday mornings to GMP members: one done with the STP-PT group (pharmacological therapeutic follow-up and individualization of drug therapy), the other led by the company Lixoft (mathematical modeling of tumor growth).

I would like to thank all the colleagues of both the scientific and board committees who have worked all this year to offer you this high-quality program.

Furthermore, the GMP is setting up for the first time, student grants for its 2021 congress. The objective of these grants is to offer access to the congress to students interested in pharmacokinetics and other ADME areas.

You will find all information related to our events and to these points in this newsletter.

But above all, we hope to see many of you at these GMP days on this new site and with this innovative scientific program which should allow us to meet, exchange and share together as we know so well how to do. Take care.



Satellite sessions

This year before the symposium, the GMP offers two free satellite sessions for its members on the morning of Wednesday, October 20th (9h30-12h30) at Espace Diderot.

Satellite 1: Treatment individualization: improving interactions between industry and hospital. (this session will be in French)

GMP and STP-PT (Suivi Thérapeutique Pharmacologique & Personnalisation des Traitements) group of SFPT (Société de Pharmacologie Francaise et de Thérapeutique) are happy to invite you to their first

common session which will take place before the start of GMP 2021 symposium.

The objective of the session is to settle a dialog between the different stakeholders involved in treatment individualization, that is hospital practitioners, software developers, and scientists involved in industrial drug development, so that they can imagine together new solutions to improve treatment individualization.

The session will be chaired by Romain Guilhaumou, hospital practitioner and president of the STP-PT group, and Florence Gattacceca, associate professor and member of GMP board. Several facilitators from hospital, software and pharma companies have volunteered to present you during the first hour about their experiences and specific issues. After a coffee break to initiate the dialog, 1.5h will be devoted to a round-table, during which all attendees will be invited to feed the discussion. The outcome of these discussions will then be published.

Exchanges will take place in French. Registration is free but mandatory. We expect many of you, from hospitals, private companies and regulatory agencies. Satellite 2: Tumor growth (session led by Lixoft). This session will be in English.

A variety of models based on differential equations have been published to describe tumor size data. This workshop will give an overview of the most common ones and their inclusion in a modular library, and will show modeling examples on real data.

It will consist of two parts. The first part will include an overview of the usual models for tumor growth, effect and delay of treatment, and their underlying assumptions, while the second part will examine the emergence of resistance and additional characteristics such as the angiogenesis and immune dynamics.

In this workshop, you will learn:

- How to choose an appropriate tumor growth model for your data and adapt it ٠
- Good practices for parameter estimation, model diagnostics and simulations ٠
- How to combine tumor growth with PK measurements or time to event data •

Student webinar



On May 28, the GMP organized its first student webinar devoted to the pharmacokinetic professions. Through 4 talks of 20 minutes each, 5 professionals from the pharmaceutical industry allowed participants to discover 4 different professions from research to clinical development:

- Pharmacokinetic support in research by Massimiliano Fonsi, (Charles Rivers) and Madani Rachid (M&Y Chemical and Pharma Consulting)
- In vitro pharmacokinetics and the role of pre-clinical project team member by Agnès Poirier, (Roche)
- The role of pharmacokinetic team member in clinical projects by Sylvaine Cartot-Cotton (Sanofi)
- Pharmacokinetic modeling from the early phases to clinical development by Sylvain Fouliard (Servier)

At the end of the presentations, students had the opportunity for 30 minutes to ask questions to stakeholders via the chat. It was the place for a nice exchange.

This webinar turned out to be a real success with over 105 participants, both students (Master 1 & 2, PhD students / 86% from Pharmacy, 14% from science faculties) and teachers. We received a lot of very positive feedback about this webinar and we are very happy that it was able to meet expectations (60% of survey responders found it very useful and 40% useful). In vitro pharmacokinetics, preclinical and clinical pharmacokinetic development, and PK modeling are topics that participants would like to develop at an upcoming event.
