REPORT OF SURVEY 2018

Among the participants of the GMP 2018 Symposium, **24%** answered our satisfaction survey, and we thank them because your opinions and suggestions are essential to the adaptation of this association which is yours. The vast majority of the assessments confirm the efforts made with the organization, but we will remain vigilant on some points such as the quality of the breaks which are for you the occasion of very interesting discussions with the other guests.

As in previous years, you always seem to be asking for a **variety of sessions** that cover Drug Metabolism & Pharmacokinetics from Research to Clinical stages. However, we note that you would like the speakers to illustrate their presentations with **more concrete cases** that will reflect your daily practice. Concerning the topics that you propose in this survey, we transmitted them to our scientific committee to meet your expectations. If any of these topics can not be addressed during our 2019 symposium, we will do our best to propose a related **webinar** because your feedback on the first one (which focused on immunogenicity) encourages us to organize other webinars (you particularly asked for a webinar on the PK/PD of biologics). You appreciated that, for the first time, a session called **"one step aside"** was organized (this year it was about the links between DMPK and doping). That is why we plan to renew this approach in the future. We also

would like to keep other elements that you plebiscite such as the students "poster blitz" and the intervention of a "keynote speaker".

The idea of a **round table**, to discuss scientific news, issued at the General Assembly was also reaffirmed in this survey. If the practical organization does not allow it this year, efforts will be made to organize it in the years to come. Moreover and as evoked during the appreciated (despite the use of French regretted by some of our non-French speaking guests) Presidents' session (see article and photo associated), we note your recommendation for the « come back » of commissions in charge of working on DMPK sub-topics (outside the symposium).

Publication of the book « Pharmacocinétique : les fondamentaux »

Co-written by the professors of **GEPK** (Groupement des Enseignants de Pharmacocinétique) and coordinated by **Pr. Etienne CHATELUT**, this 408 page-book written in French synthesizes **up-to-date** knowledge in the field and provides the necessary tools for understanding the **pharmacokinetic concepts** and their implementation in practice, **in R&D and therapeutics**. A very helpful present that will be offered to the winners of the GMP student poster awards in 2019!
